Whereas, pursuant to our file No. 208473/90, whereby the Asociación de Criadores de Caballos Falabella applies for the admission of its selection, zootechnical, and registration activities and its breeding plans, and

Considering,

That said Association was authorized to operate as a Legal Entity, as per Resolution No. 001006, dated June 22, 1990, by the General Inspection Office of Justice;

That the Registration Rules and Conformation Standards aim to preserve the identity of the Falabella breed, make known its features and encourage the breeding of the strains born in our country, as well as their offspring born abroad.

Therefore,

Based on the foregoing, and pursuant to the provisions of

Section 1, Resolution No. 21/91, and as per the order of the Zootechnical Division,

The National Director of Livestock Control and Trade Resolves:

Section 1. The Genealogical Registry of the Falabella Horses and the Conformation Standards are admitted as per Section 12, Chapter III of the Registry Regulations, for the purposes stated in Resolution M.E. No. 28, dated November 4, 1974, and ruling Decree No. 907, dated March 26, 1974.

Section 2. As of the date of this provision, any amendments introduced by the Asociación de Criadores de Caballos Falabella in the Regulations of the Genealogical Registry or Conformation Standards, should be submitted for the consideration and approval of this

National Board.

Section 3.- Be this notified, served and filed.
